Dear Ms. Duncan:

I am in receipt of your letter of September 13, 2004 to Jerry D. Biggs regarding your inquiry concerning a possible FCPA violation.

I have investigated the circumstances of campaign billboards being posted prior to the filing of our issue committee registration form. I am advised that our agreement with Lamar Advertising called for such billboards to be posted on September 1. Through an inadvertent communications mishap, we did not register the committee until September 2. Enclosed for your records is a copy of a letter from Lamar documenting our agreement that the billboards were to be posted September 1.

Although I understand that no contributions were accepted nor expenditures made prior to our filing on September 2, it may be argued that the posting of the billboards constituted an expenditure. To be on the safe side, we accept a penalty of \$50 for that one day delay in the filing of our registration. Our check in the amount of \$50 is enclosed.

Please accept my apologies for this oversight. Thank you for your assistance.
