The Colorado County Clerks Association has established a scholarship fund to aid outstanding Colorado seniors in furthering their education at any university, college, junior college, or technical institution.

- Selection will be based on the following:
 - Completed application
 - 3.25 GPA Minimum
 - Community involvement with an interest in government, business or political science.
 - Financial need/hardship
- The Colorado County Clerks Association will grant four regional one-time awards in the amount of \$500 to four seniors graduating from Colorado high schools.
- Financial aid awarded by the association will be remitted to the institution of attendance and will be credited to the student's account. The scholarship monies are to be used for tuition, books, room and board expenses.
- Each applicant must furnish three complete copies of the application to their local county clerk by **March 1st**. (Applications postmarked, but not received by March 1st, will not be considered.) Photos and folders/binders are not required.
- Each district will select a finalist and forward their selection to the Executive Board by April 15th. Members of the Executive Board of the County Clerk's Association will finalize the scholarship awards by May 1st.
- The scholarships will be awarded at graduation.
