Filing Dates for 2006 Fair Campaign Practices Act Reports
For Service District Candidates

CRS 1-45-108 (2)(a)(II) Such reports that are required to be filed with the county clerk and recorder or with the municipal clerk shall be filed on the twenty-first day and on the Friday before and thirty days after the primary election, where applicable, and the major election in election years and annual in off-election years on the first day of the month in which the anniversary of the major election occurs.

CRS 1-45-110 states that when any individual becomes a candidate, such individual shall certify, by affidavit filed with the appropriate officer within ten days, that the candidate is familiar with the provisions of this article; except that an individual who is a candidate in a special legislative election that filed a candidate affidavit for the preceding general election shall not be required to comply with the provisions of this section, and except that a candidate in a special district election shall file the candidate affidavit or, alternatively, a copy of the candidate's self-nomination and acceptance form or letter submitted in accordance with section 32-1-804.3, C.R.S., if such form or letter contains a statement that the candidate is familiar with the provisions of this article, no later than the date established for certification of the special district's ballot pursuant to section 1-5-203 (3) (a).

CRS 1-45-108(3) – All candidate committees, political committees, issue committees, small donor committees and political parties shall register with the appropriate officer before accepting or making any contributions.

SOS Rule 5.8 – The reporting period for any report that is required to be filed with the county clerk and recorder shall close five days prior to the date that the report is due.
