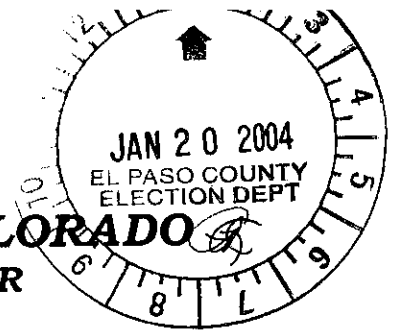

(CRS 1-45-103(2)).
