(CRS 1-45-103(2)).

The chairman of the meeting then called for the election of officers of the committee. The following persons were nominated and elected to the office preceding their name:

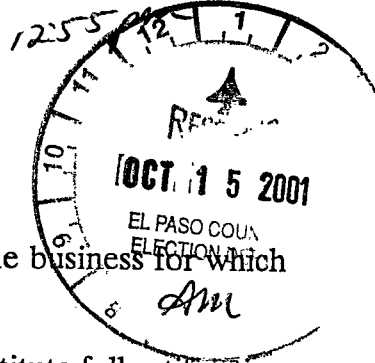
