<p>CRS 1-45-108 (2)(a)(II) Such reports that are required to be filed with the county clerk and recorder or with the municipal clerk shall be filed on the twenty-first day and on the Friday before and thirty days after the primary election, where applicable, and the major election in election years and annual in off-election years on the first day of the month in which the anniversary of the major election occurs.</p>

<p>November 1, 2004 Annual Disclosure Report</p>	<p>Annually in off-election years for Committees that have not terminated.</p>
<p>December 2, 2004 (30 days after the General Election)</p>	<p>October 25, 2004 through November 30, 2004</p>
<p>CRS 1-45-108(3) – All candidate committees, political committees, issue committees, small donor committees and political parties shall register with the appropriate officer before accepting or making any contributions. SOS Rule 25.4 – The post election reporting period closed on the last day of the calendar month in which the election was held. The report shall be filed on or before the 30th day following the election. SOS Rule 25.8 – The reporting period for any report that is required to be filed with the county clerk and recorder shall close five days prior to the date that the report is due.</p>
