CRS 1-45-108(3) – All candidate committees, political committees, issue committees, small donor committees and political parties shall register with the appropriate officer before accepting or making any contributions.

SOS Rule 5.8 – The reporting period for any report that is required to be filed with the county clerk and recorder shall close five days prior to the date that the report is due.
