

## El Paso County Clerk and Recorder Filing Dates for 2005 Fair Campaign Practices Act Reports

CRS 1-45-108 (2)(a)(II) Such reports that are required to be filed with the county clerk and recorder or with the municipal clerk shall be filed on the twenty-first day and on the Friday before and thirty days after the primary election, where applicable, and the major election in election years and annual in off-election years on the first day of the month in which the anniversary of the major election occurs.	
<b>Report Filing Dates</b>	<b>Dates covered for each filing</b>
<b>October 11, 2005</b> (21 days before the Coordinated Election)	Registration date or date of last reporting period through October 6, 2005
<b>October 28, 2005</b> (Friday before the Coordinated Election)	October 7, 2005 through October 23, 2005
<b>November 1, 2005</b> Annual Disclosure Report	Annually in off-election years for Committees that have not terminated. Nov 28, 04-Oct 27, 05
<b>December 1, 2005</b> (30 days after the Coordinated Election)	October 24, 2005 through November 26, 2005
<p>CRS 1-45-108(3) – All candidate committees, political committees, issue committees, small donor committees and political parties shall register with the appropriate officer before accepting or making any contributions.</p> <p>SOS Rule 5.4 – The post election reporting period closes on the last day of the calendar month in which the election was held. The report shall be filed on or before the 30<sup>th</sup> day following the election.</p> <p>SOS Rule 5.8 – The reporting period for any report that is required to be filed with the county clerk and recorder shall close five days prior to the date that the report is due.</p>
