

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR EMISSIONS EXTENSION

NOTE: This form *MUST* be completed in full. An incomplete form will be rejected, no exceptions.

- A. If the student is not an owner on the vehicle, please include the student's name in the mailing address.
- B. If a Military Non Resident Affidavit was used last year to buy your plates, you must apply for plates in the state you are now stationed at or in your home of record state (***enlisted military individual MUST be an owner/lessor of the vehicle or you must check reason "F" and follow those requirements***).
- C. This exemption can only be taken one time. If vehicle does not return to Colorado, you must register in that state.
- D. A "VIN Verification" signed by law enforcement or Motor Vehicle office may be sent in place of repair receipts.
- E. An emissions test is required unless vehicle is located in a non-emission area. When in a non-emission area, a "VIN Verification" must be submitted. This exemption can only be taken one time. If vehicle does not return to Colorado, you must register in that state.

A "VIN Verification" must be submitted to verify vehicle is located out of state. This exemption can only be taken one time. If vehicle does not return to Colorado, you must register in that state.

Call (719) 520-6240 to receive a faxed/mailed "VIN Verification". A Law Enforcement Officer or the Motor Vehicle Department agent must complete this form.

APPLICATION FOR AN AFFIDAVIT OF EMISSIONS EXTENSION

(SEE BACK FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS)

Completed ORIGINAL application must be submitted to your COLORADO LOCAL COUNTY MOTOR VEHICLE CLERK'S OFFICE with your vehicle license renewal notice, proof of insurance and payment. FURTHER INFORMATION MAY BE REQUIRED IN ORDER TO HAVE THE REQUEST APPROVED. HOWEVER, A COMPLETED APPLICATION DOES NOT ASSURE AUTOMATIC APPROVAL.

ALL INFORMATION REQUESTED ON THIS FORM MUST BE SUPPLIED BY THE APPLICANT OR THE EXTENSION WILL BE DENIED.

- Emissions extension is granted for up to a 12-month period.
- Vehicles registered on this extension application MUST be inspected immediately upon return to Colorado.
- A valid Emissions Inspection shall be required at the time of renewal.
- Owners of vehicles that do not comply with the inspection requirements upon return to Colorado are subject to penalties as defined in C.R.S. 42-4-313.

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REASON FOR EXTENSION

A - Out of State Student

Vehicle owner and/or immediate family member who is out of state attending school on a full-time basis.

B - Out of State Military

Vehicle owner and/or spouse who is out of state on **active** duty in a branch of the United States military. Military individual **must** be the owner or co-owner of the vehicle

C - Seasonally Out of State

Vehicle owner who spends a portion of the year (less than 12 months) and returns the vehicle to Colorado **every** year. **It is strongly recommended that the vehicle owner change the registration cycle to coincide with when the vehicle is in Colorado to avoid Emission Extensions every year.**

D - Vehicle Disabled Out of State

Vehicle owner and/or immediate family member who had the vehicle out of state when it became disabled due to a vehicle accident or engine trouble. **Must provide receipts from the repair shop or store where parts were purchased, and or any accident report if applicable.**

E - Working Out of State

Vehicle owner and/or immediate family member who is working in any capacity out of state. **Some states require registration if individual is working in their state (i.e. Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, California, Florida, Louisiana, Montana, Nevada, North Dakota, Texas, Utah and Wyoming). If the state in which the vehicle is currently in requires an emission test, you must submit an emission test from that state with your application. If not, you must submit a vehicle identification number verification (VIN) from the state the vehicle is currently in with your application.**

F - Temporarily Out of State

Vehicle owner and/or immediate family member who is temporarily out of state for family emergency, caring for a sick relative, settling family estate, etc. **This category should not be confused with "Working Out of State". If the state in which the vehicle is currently in requires an emission test, you must submit an emission test from that state with your application. If not you must submit a vehicle identification number verification (VIN) from the state the vehicle is currently in with your application.**

LOWER PORTION OF FORM

The "**Name of Out of State Contact**", "**Address of Out of State Contact**", "**City**", "**State**", "**ZIP**", and "**Contact Phone #**", is the information necessary for verification (i.e. school, school's complete address, registrar's phone number), (i.e. military installation, complete address, main branch phone number), (i.e. repair shop, shop's address and phone number), etc. *Under "Name of Out of State Contact", include the name of the individual if other than the registered vehicle owner.*

The **Social Security Number (SSN)** is the number for the individual that is out of state with the vehicle.

Military ID# *is required* for all individuals requesting as extension based on "**Out of State Military**".

Month/Year of Return to Colorado *is mandatory!* Extensions are granted for up to 12 months only and/or until your next registration period.

Out of State Address to mail registration to *is necessary* to mail the renewal tabs and registration to where the vehicle is located out of state. Renewal tabs and registration will not be mailed to a "Colorado" address or handed to the individual over the counter.

REMINDER

All areas of the application must be filled out or the application will be returned "INCOMPLETE". This may result in a delay in your license plates being renewed.

Completed applications must be submitted to your Colorado local county motor vehicle office.
