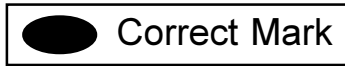


## HOW TO VOTE YOUR BALLOT

Please read your ballot completely before voting. Any unnecessary marks or erasures may cause your ballot to be misread.

Completely fill in the oval next to your candidate or issue choice, as shown below, using dark ink:

## HOW TO VOTE FOR A QUALIFIED WRITE-IN CANDIDATE

- John Doe
- George Washington

To vote for a qualified WRITE-IN candidate, whose name is not printed on the ballot, print the name of the WRITE-IN candidate on the blank line.

Darken the oval next to the name you have printed. THIS OVAL MUST BE FILLED IN.

## AFTER VOTING

Place the voted ballot in the secrecy envelope.

Place the sealed secrecy envelope inside the yellow "return envelope".  
**SIGN YOUR NAME AND PROVIDE YOUR DATE OF BIRTH ON THE BACK OF THE YELLOW ENVELOPE.**

You may hand deliver your voted ballot to:

To mail your voted ballot, affix proper postage as noted on yellow envelope. Ballots received after 7:00 p.m. on Election Day will not be counted. To ensure that your ballot is counted, please mail early.

This may not be your only ballot. Other elections may be held by other political subdivisions by mail or polling place.
