To receive your ballot by mail, you must submit your request in writing to the El Paso County Clerk, PO Box 2007, Colorado Springs, CO 80901-2007, no later than the Tuesday before an election. You may also fax your request to (719) 520-7327. Your full name, birthdate, residence address, party affiliation, address to which ballot should be mailed, and signature are required. Please request your ballot as early as possible.
